WINE MAKING

Crafted with pristine fruit, hand harvested from 15-year-old vines in the Queensbury sub-region of Central Otago. The wine was first crushed and allowed an hour of skin contact, around 15% was then racked to old oak, wild fermented and went through a partial malolactic fermentation, with the remaining being cool fermented in stainless steel before bottling in August 2020

TASTING NOTES

The 2020 Mount Michael Pinot Gris is all about palate weight, texture, and balance with wonderful aromas of bruleed pears, ginger and spice followed by a rich, concentrated mouthful of baked pears and custard apples with a long textural finish, balanced with perfect refreshing acidity.
